

How to get to Chicoutimi on arrival day: Sunday, May 15, 2016

FLYING TO BAGOTVILLE	BY CAR
<p>There are many daily flights from Dorval YUL (Montreal) airport to Bagotville YBG (Chicoutimi) airport. It is a one hour flight.</p> <p>Explore bursary students will have a 15% discount for travelling with Porter Airlines. If interested, please communicate with the École de langue française in order to receive a code which will allow you to enjoy the discount.</p> <p>You must make your own travel arrangement with the airline of your choice.</p> <p>Should you choose this option, you will either have to take a taxi (approx. \$25) or take the public transport to get to your final destination.</p>	<p>Car travel is also a good way of coming to Chicoutimi. The trip could be faster than by bus and you would have more freedom in getting around throughout the duration of your program.</p> <p>Students who wish to bring their car must purchase, at their own expense, a parking sticker at the reception of the University upon arrival.</p> <p>It is very important that you let us know that you are coming by car prior to your departure.</p>
